

Interactive Session on Culture Media & Culture Methods by Dr. Raufu Ibrahim Adisa for Teaching Staff of CGBIBT

An interactive session on “Culture Media & Culture Methods” was conducted for the faculty members of C.G. Bhakta Institute of Biotechnology by Dr. Raufu Ibrahim Adisa on 09-02-2019.

Dr. Raufu, an Associate Professor at the Department of Veterinary Microbiology, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, University of Ilorin, Nigeria, joined C.G. Bhakta Institute of Biotechnology with a three-month research fellowship awarded to him by the University of Ilorin, Nigeria through N.G. Patel International Fellowship under the Mentorship of Prof. Dr. R. Krishnamurthy. The main highlight of Dr. Raufu Ibrahim's talk was on “Microbial Infection and Clinical Diagnosis of Human Diseases”. Dr. Raufu emphasized that the isolation and identification of such pathogenic organisms is an essential part of effective infection prevention and control.

Dr. Raufu also explained the types and preparation of various differential and selective media for the isolation and identification of pathogenic organisms like *Salmonella*, *Listeria* and *E.coli*. Overall, his lecture was greatly useful to the laboratory and academic staff of CGBIBT.
