

Purpose:

Orientation Program Components

DAY 1: 25th July 2022, Manjula Hall



Each year, the University Welcome to "New Students" marks the commencement of the Orientation Program. The orientation ceremony was attended by the new entrants and their parents. The student volunteers helped to organize the entire proceedings. The students were assisting in crowd control, stage activities and hospitality as well. The session began with the university song. Ms. Amita Rathod gave welcome speech followed by lamp lightening ceremony paying tribute to goddess saraswati. Video of UTU students sharing their experience of learning was shared on screen to freshers and parents.

Different sessions of eminent personalities were covered in programme to motivate fresher students.



SESSION-1: Prof. Parth Parmar



He introduced various departments and courses offered at UKA TARSADIA UNIVERSITY by means of wonderful videos. He explained the role of donors in upliftment of university. He covered the types of scholarships including B.U. PATEL scholarship in his session. He explained importance of living TAILOR MADE LIFE to students. He motivated students to strongly identify set of skills and to have different perspectives. He focussed on identifying own individuality. He conveyed message to live customised life rather than default life.

SESSION-2: Prof. Bhavik Sarang



He explained students how they can discover their passion with UTU. He described in detail on each cells and clubs of UTU. He clearly explained activities done at UKA TARSADIA UNIVERSITY under each cell and clubs. He explained importance of Entrepreneurship Development & Start cell motivating students to have innovative ideas by giving examples such as eatable spoon, cycle for coconut tree, concept of e-cycle in city like Surat. He covered all activities under International Collaboration cell, Training cell & Placement cell, Women cell, Counselling committee and committee against sexual harassment. He also gave details of each clubs like Dance, Music, Literary, Theatre, Social Service and Media & Press which focuses on upbringing talent of students on stage.

SESSION-3: Prof. Krutarth Patel



He organised a very special event called "Treasure Hunt" for freshers with the help of volunteers to explain concepts of "BIODIVERSITY" at UTU campus. He identified our campus to be rich in



BIODIVERSITY by informing students about 350+ species of plant/ tree, 45+ Bird species, 25+ Spider species, 30+ Butterfly species, 10+ Reptile species. He explained importance of each species like Bay Weaver, Spider, Butterfly, Ants etc. He conveyed we should respect and conserve biodiversity of nature at campus. Documentary film "INDIA 'S WILD KARNATAKA" by RAJKUMAR RAO was shown to all at the end of session.

DAY 2: 26th July 2022, Manjula Hall

SESSION-1: Prof. Manjunath Beth



He very nicely introduced concept of Life Saving Skill to the audience. He defined "Basic First Aid" as a basic treatment given to victim before sending him to hospital. He clearly explained that the purpose of First Aid is to save life, to prevent suffering, to prevent secondary complications and to promote speedy recovery. He also discussed qualities of First Aider and Action Plan. Concept of CARDIAC ARREST and CPR –CARDIAC PULMONARY RESUSCITATION was excellently explained with help of models and students. Causes of Cardiac arrest, Heart attack and its indications were covered in session.

SESSION-2: Prof. Hiren Shah





He described in detail about all types of student scholarships and government/non-government schemes. EWS quota was clearly explained to students. MYSY, CMSS-Chief Minister Scholarship Scheme, PRAGATI Scholarship, SAKSHAM scholarship, MOMA-Ministry of Minority Affairs scholarship, SC, SEBC/OBC scholarship was explained to students in detail. B.U PATEL Scholarship and UTU ALUMNI ASSOCIATION scholarship of university and its eligibility criteria was explained in session. Very informative session on NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PORTAL covering methods to apply for scholarship, document required, form filling procedure and Help centre details was given by him. All activities of International Collaboration Cell was very nicely explained to students.


DAY 3: 27th July 2022, Pushpam Tarsadia Auditorium

SESSION-1: Dr. Chinmay Desai
